If you search this phrase without any additional elements, you will retrieve all of the non-fiction books in our Collection that have been identified as appropriate for a popular audience.

Searchers may also add a keyword or a classification number to the general search phrase to limit the retrieval to a particular topic or issue, e.g., 14.5 and (po[sc] not fiction) to retrieve non-fiction materials on cloning for lay persons OR euthanasia and (po[sc] not fiction).
